Jack Shadbolt was born in Shoeburyness, England, in 1909, later emigrating to Canada. He studied art in Victoria and New York, and then taught art at Kitsilano High School in Vancouver. He also published essays in *The B.C. Teacher*, the monthly magazine of the B.C. Teachers Federation.

In 1932 he travelled by car to see the Chicago World's Fair. He also viewed a Cezanne exhibition there which he stated "stunned" him. The trip continued to Toronto, then he lived for eight months in New York city before returning to Vancouver. He also exhibited with the <u>Island Arts and Crafts Society</u> in Victoria in 1932.

Shadbolt worked as a photo-classification officer in London, England during World War II, serving as a Lieutenant. He returned to Canada after the war, and began teaching painting at the <u>Vancouver</u> School of Art.

He exhibited his work in a number of the annual *B.C. Artists* exhibitions at the <u>Vancouver Art Gallery</u>, in 1936, from 1939-1943, 1946, 1947, 1949 to 1956, 1962, and 1966.

Shadbolt exhibited with the <u>B.C. Society of Fine Arts</u> in their annual exhibitions, including 1937, 1940, 1941, 1942, 1943, 1944, 1946 to 1948, 1950, 1954 to 1964, and in 1967.

He was on a list titled "<u>Leading Vancouver Artists</u>," provided to the <u>Labour Arts Guild</u> on April 10, 1946 by the <u>Vancouver Art Gallery</u> to assist in the Guild's call for entries to the second annual B.C. At Work exhibition.

Shadbolt showed his work in the 1944 and 1945 *British Columbia At Work* exhibitions. In 1946 - 1947 he had work in a <u>Federation of Canadian Artists</u> travelling <u>exhibition</u>.

He exhibited with the Royal Canadian Academy in 1941, 1942, and 1964.

He had a long and distinguished career, with numerous solo exhibitions. He continued to paint and create until his death in 1998. His wife Doris died in Mexico in 2003 of a heart attack. Following her death parts of the Shadbolt estate came onto the market, including thousands of books and exhibitions catalogues. Many of these volumes were inscribed to the Shadbolts, a number of them contained additional ephemera tucked in between the pages. One exhibition catalogue yielded the following "Chronology of Conceptual Concerns", a three-page typed manuscript that includes a range of dates from 1926 to 1977, although the manuscript is otherwise undated.
